KINGS COURSE LOCAL RULES

1 Out of Bounds (Rule 18.2)

Beyond any boundary fences or hedges and beyond any line of white stakes on the left of 3rd, left of 5th, left and behind 9th , back of 15th, right of and behind 18th Green

Internal Out of Bounds: During play of the hole shown this is defined by;

- a **6th Hole** to right of white stakes to ditch going across and then anywhere on the 7th hole or Jubilee course, identified by white stakes with black tops.
- b **8th Hole** In and beyond the ditch behind the 8th green.
- c **13th Hole** Beyond white stakes to right side of hole - on or over the footpath to the right of the hole & anywhere on the 14th Hole.
- d **14th Hole** White stakes to the left of 14th - these apply only when playing the 14th hole.
- e **15th Hole** Beyond the boundary hedge over the path is OOB -the path is in bounds - drop may be taken no nearer the hole.
- f **18th Hole** Beyond gravel filled ditch & open ditch to the left as identified by white / black posts, then over ditch to the left of the 1st to the path side of the 1st tee, defined by white posts.

White stakes with black top identify OOB and do NOT define it and are **immoveable** obstructions when playing any hole.

The internal out of bounds stakes on 13th and 14th are boundary objects when playing the hole concerned and are **immoveable** obstructions on other holes.

2 Penalty Areas (Rule 17)

Penalty areas right of 6th Hole and left of 18th (Opposite side relief next to internal boundaries) When a ball last crossed the edge of the red penalty areas above where the edge of the red penalty area and an internal boundary of the course coincide, opposite side relief is available under Model Local Rule B-2.1

3 Abnormal Course Conditions (Rule 16).

This includes Immoveable Obstructions All artificial and manmade paths and Ditches which have been filled with gravel. Fences and protective netting which do not define the boundary of the course.

No Play Zones

Ground under Repair is marked by white or blue lines and/or hoops and/ or signs. Relief must be taken unless otherwise indicated including the

protection of any young tree identified by stakes or wrapping.

13th Hole Footpath Protective Netting additional relief option

As an extra relief option for the protective netting on the right-hand side of hole, a player may drop a ball in the dropping zone which is situated to the left of the netting. A player would get relief under rule 16.1. There is no relief for line of play. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3.

Unhealed Drainage Channels, Cuts or Ruts

Such areas are deemed to be Ground under Repair from which relief may be taken under Rule 16.1. These include drainage works which have reopened, been sanded filled or contain gravel/ stones or sunken.

Unless otherwise determined by a Rule of Golf- Breach of Local Rule:

General Penalty

Matchplay - Loss of Hole; Strokeplay - 2 strokes

JUBILEE COURSE LOCAL RULES

The Local Rules & Temporary Rules currently in force, are displayed in the clubhouse and take precedence over the rules printed on the scorecard.

Out of Bounds

In or over all course boundary fences, hedges or ditches.
There is no free relief from boundary objects or integral objects that interfere with play.

Internal Out of Bounds

- a) 7th hole -Right of the white stakes between 7th and 8th
- b) 13th hole -Right of the white stakes between the 13th & 12th holes
- c) 17th hole -Left of the white stakes along the footpath
- d) 18th hole -Left of the white stakes beyond the ditch

No Play Zones - Rule 16.1f & 16.1e

Any area marked as a **No Play Zone**, GUR or marked with a white or blue line.

Any staked trees or shrubs
If a player's ball is in a **No Play Zone** or the condition Interferes with the players stance or area of intended swing, relief must be taken under Rule 16.1
Abnormal Course Conditions (Rule 16). This includes Immovable Obstructions and Ground under Repair.
Immovable Obstructions include:

- All artificially surfaced pathways including those covered with woodchip

Unhealed Drainage Channels, Cuts or Ruts

Such areas are deemed to be Ground under Repair from which relief may be taken under Rule 16.1. These include drainage works which have reopened, been sanded, filled or contain gravel/stones.

Unless otherwise determined by a Rule of Golf-Breach of Local Rule:

General Penalty
Stroke play ... 2 Strokes
Matchplay... Loss of Hole

Indemnity

All golf related activities can be dangerous. It is a condition of membership and the use of the course and facilities of Three Rivers Golf & Country Club that players, visitors, and members carry their own Insurance and Indemnify the Company against all claims in respect of any Injury, damage or loss arising out of their presence on the course or in the clubhouse area.

The Company will accept no liability in respect of any injury, loss or damage however caused. Players are reminded of Rule 1 section 2 of the Rules of Golf which requires players to look out for the safety of others.

Particular care must be taken to look out for and give way to walkers using the public footpath which passes to the back of the 2nd, right of the 3rd, left of the 14th, left of the 17th and the back of the 18th.
